In regards to IT security, operating system security provides for the foundation around which the rest of the software stack can build its security. AIX historically has provided for strong operating system security. AIX builds on that security and provides for multiple security features addressing varied types of threats for different operating environments. In this workshop you will be introduced to the concepts associated to AIX users and groups and the ways of controlling access to system wide critical accounts and system files.
