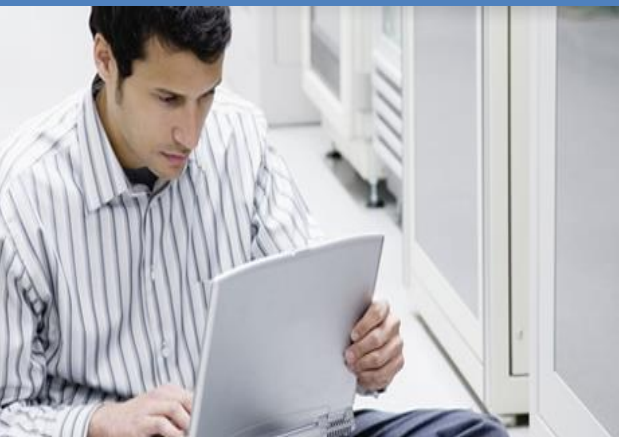


AIX System Configuration Devices and AIX System Storage Overview – Customer Onsite
